## **PART BRED CLYDESDALE REGISTRY** **Regulations for Registration (2017)**

**Revised 19<sup>th</sup> February 2018**

**Please note:** That the regulations as outlined in the Commonwealth Clydesdale Horse Society Stud Book Entry Regulations with the exception of Regulations 9, 14 and 19 also apply for the registration of horses in the CCHS Part Bred Registry.

### **1) General:**

- a) In these regulations, "the Society" and "CCHS" mean the Commonwealth Clydesdale Horse Society Australia.
- b) Until otherwise determined by the CCHS Federal Council, the following regulations of the Society govern the recording of a Part Bred Clydesdale in the Society's Part Bred Registry.

### **2) The Part Bred Register:**

- a) Any horse shall be eligible for the CCHS Part Bred Registry provided that:
  - i. either the sire or dam of the horse is a registered Clydesdale Horse in any recognised Clydesdale Stud Book and;
  - ii. the other parent's breed and name is known.
- b) The horse must be microchipped prior to registration and the number recorded on the Registration Application Form.
- c) The horse must be branded according to the regulations stated in the CCHS Stud Book Entry Regulations and branded with an "X" beside and in front of the breeding/year numbers.
- d) Part Bred horses shall be allocated the suffix "X" in front of their registration number on the Certificate of Registration.
- e) Horses born before 1<sup>st</sup> August 2012 will be accepted at the discretion of the Federal Council Executive.
- f) Horses born after 31<sup>st</sup> July 2012 and before 1<sup>st</sup> August 2017 will be accepted with proof of breeding:
  - i. a service certificate if the horse is sired by a registered Clydesdale stallion;
  - ii. the other parent's breed and name is known; and
  - iii. a Statutory Declaration to be provided to confirm lineage.
- g) Horses born after the 1<sup>st</sup> August 2017 will be accepted with either:
  - i. a service certificate if the horse is sired by a registered Clydesdale stallion; and
  - ii. the other parent's breed and name is known.

- h) All horses registered in the CCHS Part Bred Registry are ineligible for registration and/or transfer into the Commonwealth Clydesdale Horse Stud Book.
- i) The offspring of a first cross Part Bred Clydesdale, registered in this registry, shall be eligible for the CCHS Part Bred Registry if:
  - i. either the sire or dam of the horse is a registered Clydesdale Horse in any recognised Clydesdale Stud Book;
  - ii. a service certificate if the horse is sired by a registered Clydesdale stallion; and
  - iii. the other parent's breed and name is known.
- j) The offspring of any further crosses of a CCHS Part Bred Horse are not allowed in this registry.
- k) Applications for registration shall only be accepted on the prescribed form and from the registered owner, who is to be a current member of the Society and has a registered Stud Prefix and Stud Brand with the Society.
- l) All current fees for the registration of Pure Bred Clydesdales will apply to the recording of part bred horses.
- m) It is not compulsory for an owner to be a financial member of the Society to transfer a horse to a new owner, but the applicable non-member fee will apply.

### **3) The Society's Part Bred Registry is NOT OPEN to:**

- a) A horse eligible for registration in any of the pure bred sections of the CCHS Stud Book.

### **4) Showing:**

- a) Horses registered in the Clydesdale Part Bred Registry are ineligible for entry in CCHS Clydesdale Pure Bred show classes.
- b) Horses registered in Clydesdale Part Bred Registry are eligible for CCHS Part Bred Clydesdale show classes and can only be shown by the registered owner, who is to be a current financial member of the Society at events where requested.
